### From the President.....

Hi members, I hope everyone is keeping well with all the inclement weather we are getting. I'm afraid there is not much to report on this month due to a number of shows having to be cancelled due to the big wet, and if the predictions are right the next month will be more of the same. Fingers crossed they have it wrong this time.

With all this rain comes a number of potential problems. Firstly biting insects, in some areas they are breeding thick and fast which can quickly lead to itchy horses, especially if the suffer from rain scald and lose patches of hair and allow insects easy access, so it can be hard sometimes to determine the root cause of itch especially in a horse that has previously never suffered itch.

The other prevalent problem is hooves; they aren't designed to be waterlogged for long periods. This can itself lead to any number of problems, white line disease, seedy toe and thrush just to name a few, none of which can be magically prevented in weather like we are currently experiencing. The only real defence against this, if possible is to keep horses out of boggy pastures or pens. Secondly good hoof care will go a long way towards preventing most hoof problems, regular cleaning and trimming to keep flares at bay so as not to stress the laminae and allow easier access of moisture and other foreign debris into the white line.

Hopefully there will be something more pleasant to talk about next month. Till then keep well.

#### A quick note about some changes and additions to the HI POINT classes:

\*\*The following 2 classes have been added to the program\*\*

\*BEGINNER CHILD HANDLER 2 - 6 YEARS (handlers to be assisted by a parent or appropriate adult who must be a financial member)

\*LEADLINE: CHILDREN 2 - 6 YEARS (to be assisted by a parent or appropriate adult who must be a financial member)

It was brought to the attention of the committee that the Lead line class is in the Hi Point list of awards but not provided in any show program except at the PHPA Championship show. This class has now been included in the program for 10 nominated shows. Also introduced to give our youth of tomorrow a start today – the 'Beginner Child' handler class, all children in these classes MUST be assisted by PHPA financial parent OR an appropriate adult who is a financial member: please make sure your memberships are up to date if you have a child you would like entered in these classes.

\*Another change in the Hi point program this year has been brought about by the decline in numbers for the Led Sporting events, in the past these events were limited to ponies under 14 hh that were not ridden under saddle. 2 years ago these classes were dropped from our program due to lack of numbers, last year it was decided to include them again but support was minimal. The current committee has decided try to boost entry numbers by making a rule change which will be trailed this season. There is no height restriction, horses 14 hh or over can enter; horses or ponies that are ridden under saddle may also be entered in the sporting events -HOWEVER, this is only the case IF the handler for the sporting events does is not the rider for under saddle classes. Example - Jane Smith rides her Pinto 'Fred' in under saddle classes so she cannot do the sporting classes, but 'Fred' can do the sporting classes if he is led by a financial member of Jane's family or another non riding PHPA financial member. Results will still be allocated to under 14 hh performance where applicable. We are hoping that this move will boost the numbers so these classes can remain in the program and boost entry fees for the shows that hold our Hi Point classes. If you are unsure about your eligibility for these classes please contact a committee member.
