# SHOW SEASON...... IT'S UPON US AGAIN

Show season... for many of us Pinto owners it's time to be thinking about getting ready for shows or whatever discipline you compete your Pinto in.

There are a few things to remember if you are competing – you must make sure your membership is current and your Pinto registered before you can enter the show ring or event - registered Pintos whose owners are non-financial are considered 'registration inoperative ' and therefore cannot be competed (see PHPA Rules & regulations)

HI – POINTS.....Don't forget to nominate for Hi Points if you are out showing or competing - we have categories for halter, ridden, Pony Club, Dressage etc. Nomination for the season is only \$15 per Pinto - the form is on the website and if you don't already have a points recording book you can order one on the same form for \$15

**Amateur Owner:** We frequently get asked 'What Is An Amateur Owner" and 'can I apply for an A/O card'. In short here is the PHPA's A/O requirements...

'To qualify as an Amateur Owner you must be over the age of 18 years and not receive remuneration for training other people's horses, giving lessons to people and/or receiving any form of sponsorship be it money or products - Horse or Pony must be registered with the PHPA to compete in A/O classes. A/O cards are \$15 annually, the form is also available on the website

Filling in your Results book: Please be sure to fill in your results book properly, don't forget to include a copy of the event cover/front page as well as the page/s of the classes you placed in ( If you have a very large show schedule you don't need to send the whole thing – just the front cover with event details and the classes you are claiming points for) Refer to this guide on the website for a handy 'how to' description <a href="http://www.pintohorseandponyassn.com/wp-content/uploads/Howto-fill-in-your-PHPA-Show-results-sheets.pdf">http://www.pintohorseandponyassn.com/wp-content/uploads/Howto-fill-in-your-PHPA-Show-results-sheets.pdf</a>

**WHIPS:** please take note of the rule regarding whips.... DRESSAGE whips or any whip EXCEEDING 75 cm are NOT permitted in the show ring when you are showing your Pinto as a PHPA member - this applies to our Championship Show and any event you attend/compete that holds Pinto classes.



**Safety Helmets** - ALL PHPA Youth are required to wear an approved safety helmet, this is for led classes as well as ridden classes. Approved helmets should have the following safety rating:

ASNZ 3838 (Aus/ N.Z standard)

Also approved are: EN 1384, PAS 015, ASTM F1163, BSEN 1384



**Please Note:** Anyone using an EN 1384 helmet will be able to continue using it until **the** end of 2016.

As of January 1st 2017 the EN 1384 safety helmet will no longer be approved. Now would be a good time to check all your child's (and your) helmet and make sure they meet the current safety requirements



## PHPA NOMINATED 'HI – POINT' SHOWS

The PHPA offers annual trophies and awards for members who nominate and compete with their Pinto's each year, our Hi Point season commences 1<sup>st</sup> August each year so results sent in from 1 Aug to 31 July of each season will be recorded with our Point Score Officer (remember – you need to send in results from a minimum of 3 shows/competitions etc to qualify)

Each year the PHPA has 'double point' shows – these are our 'Nominated Hi Point' shows where we have our full program of Pinto classes included at participating Ag Shows as well as our own annual Championship Show which is TRIPLE POINTS!!
