All forms are downloadable from the 'Requirements & Forms' page; if you cannot print them off please contact the Secretary or another committee member (details are on the 'Contact' page)

Please take the time to read through the forms and instructions before filling them out, there are instruction sheets for registration applications if you are unclear on anything; if you have any questions contact a committee member.

Please fill in the forms completely, remember to sign and date all forms, incomplete forms can't be processed, they will be returned for completion.

Remember to include any copies of paperwork that your form may request; i.e service certificates.

Payment: you can pay by Cheque, money order etc or electronic funds transfer. If paying by EFT please use the details provided on the website 'Association Fees' page and please remember to send a copy of the EFT for our records - 'no receipt...no paperwork processed' *Note that sending a payment by EFT without the accompanying forms does not automatically provide instant membership, registration etc, all payments are considered 'pending' until paperwork is processed and approved.

We recommend that you keep a copy of all forms you fill in and send in case your originals get lost by the postal system. Sending by Express post is also recommended.

Thank you for following correct procedure - it makes the Secretaries job a lot easier and quicker if done correctly first time and saves disappointment when delays occur while getting errors or omissions corrected.
